## Asking "God" Questions

**The questions we ask shape how we think about God, our congregation, each other, and our neighborhood.**

**We want to learn to regularly ask "God Questions" of each other along this journey.**

### **Examples of "God Questions"**

- What might God be up to?
- What might God be saying to us?
- Where is God already present in our daily lives (in our workplaces, neighborhoods and other places we spend our time)?
- What does God care about in our local communities?
- Where is God already touching peoples' lives outside the congregation?
- Where are people experiencing God's love? God's mercy? God's grace?
- How might God be leading our congregation to join in something God is already doing?

### **Practice:**

1. Make a list, as a group, of some of the "church questions" you hear people in your congregation asking.

*(Example: "How do we attract more young people?")*

2. Practice, with your coach and/or pastor, re-writing these questions with God in the driver's seat of the question.

*(Example: "What is God already doing in the lives of our young people? How could we join in with what God is already doing?")*
