



Field Work

1. Do the “Listening to One Another’s Stories” and “Naming God’s Activity” practices with larger groups of others in the congregation. Use the same handouts you used for your time together today. *Note: These documents are found in the same place you found the video.*

As you plan for other groups to experience this, consider:

- Are there congregational events already planned that these practices would easily fit into?
- Would you like to have your team lead the exercises, or would you want to replay this video for the larger group?

2. Record your learnings in a central place to continue sharing both inside and outside your renewal team. Consider creating a "learnings log" where you first place the learnings your team shared during this session. Then, use this same "learnings log" to record the things that congregation shares at their larger events. Find creative ways to share these learnings with the whole congregation over the next several months, to help more people benefit from the experiments your team is leading!

As you plan for other groups to experience these two activities, consider:

- How will your team record the larger groups' learnings? Big sticky notes? A laptop & a projector? Recording the learnings and sharing them with the whole congregation is key to helping the spirit of renewal spread throughout the whole church.
