

Congregational Vitality Survey Price Sheet

After a successful pilot phase with four synods, the ELCA wanted to make the comprehensive Congregational Vitality Survey available to every synod and congregation that wanted to take it, but it didn't have the capacity to provide and process those surveys in house. Therefore, the ELCA contracted with Linda Bobbitt to manage the requests, processing and report production for the comprehensive Congregational Vitality Survey. Linda is working with the University of Northern Colorado's Social Research Lab to generate and process the paper surveys. This price sheet reflects the costs associated with outsourcing the processing of the survey.

Survey Description: This is one page front/back bubble sheet style survey that congregations can give to every member who attends worship in a weekend. [Here is a sample survey without the bubbles.](#)

Deliverable: A 10 page PDF report will be created for each congregation and posted for the DEM or congregation to download. [Here is a sample report.](#)

Prices are based on the number of surveys requested and are organized into levels. Congregations are encouraged to request 5% more than average worship attendance. All questions may be directed to Office@congregationalvitalityproject.com

Order Process

The Congregational Vitality Survey is available to any congregation, but must be ordered by their Director for Evangelical Mission (DEM) or other synod staff. To order, the DEM must log into the website (www.congregationalvitalitysurvey.com), look up the congregation and request a survey using the online form. (More detailed instructions are provided at <http://elca.org/resources/dem>.) In the form there is a section where you choose the number of surveys requested and name the level (with associated price). You also indicate who will be paying for the survey (the congregation or the synod). Within a business day or so of the request being received, an invoice will be generated and sent to the congregation/synod as indicated. The invoice may be paid for by check or online using a credit card or bank transfer. Once payment is received, paper surveys will be created and mailed to the congregation with instructions for filling them out and sending them back. *Note: the surveys will come in an envelope from University of Northern Colorado's Social Research Lab.* Once the surveys are returned the final report will be ready within two weeks. The person who requested the survey will be notified when the report is ready. They are encouraged to download it and share it personally with congregation leaders.
